Section 1. Section 1004.032, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

(1) As used in this section, the term:(a) "GMAT" means the Graduate Management Admission Test.

(b) "Graduate program" means an advanced academic degree program in a specialized field of study, including, but not limited to, a master's or doctoral degree program, which degree is pursued after one has obtained a bachelor's degree.

(c) "GRE" means the Graduate Record Examination.

(d) "Institution of higher education" means a state university as defined in s. 1000.21(8).

(e) "Servicemember" has the same meaning as in s. 250.01.

(2) An institution of higher education shall waive the GRE or GMAT requirement for a servicemember who applies for admission to a graduate program that requires such examination.
