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## A bill to be entitled

An act relating to sexual misconduct information in public K-20 education; amending s. 1001.42, F.S.; requiring district school boards to provide certain information relating to Title IX and sexual misconduct complaints to parents, students, and school employees; creating s. 1004.0972, F.S.; requiring Florida College System institutions and state universities to create a sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking policy; providing requirements for such policy; requiring Florida College System institutions and state universities to create and implement a comprehensive prevention and outreach program on sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking; providing requirements for the program; requiring Florida College System institutions and state universities to provide certain information to students; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Present subsection (29) of section 1001.42, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (30), and a new subsection (29) is added to that section, to read:

1001.42 Powers and duties of district school board.—The district school board, acting as a board, shall exercise all powers and perform all duties listed below:

(29) PROVISION OF TITLE IX INFORMATION.—Each district school board shall provide to parents, students, and school

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employees the following information:

- (a) The person who serves as the Title IX Coordinator for each school.
- (b) The process for placing and filing a sexual misconduct complaint.
- (c) The support measures in place for a person who files a sexual misconduct complaint and how to access the support measures.

Section 2. Section 1004.0972, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1004.0972 Public postsecondary educational institution sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking policies.—

- (1) Each Florida College System institution and state university shall create a sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking policy. The policy must:
- (a) Be included in the institution or university's student handbook and personnel handbook.
- (b) Have a website dedicated solely to the policy. The website must be easily accessible through a link on the institution or university's website homepage.
- (2) Each Florida College System institution and state university shall:
- (a) Create and implement a comprehensive prevention and outreach program on sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking. The program must address a range of strategies to prevent sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking, including a victim empowerment program, a public awareness campaign, primary prevention strategies,

(b) Provide students with all of the following: 61 62 1. Information on the program established under paragraph 63 (a). 2. The protocols for reporting an incident of sexual 64 65 harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, or stalking, including the name, office location, and contact information of 66 67 the institution or university's Title IX Coordinator. 68 69 The information provided under this paragraph must be given to 70 students at student orientations and e-mailed to students at the 71 beginning of each semester.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
