- (d) "Sexual conduct" and the term "sexual excitement" have the same meanings as in s. 847.001.
- (e) "Sexual performance" has the same meaning as in s. 827.071(1).

(f) "Unlawful sexual behavior" means any unlawful sexual activity, unlawful sexual conduct, or unlawful sexual performance.

(2) A person 18 years of age or older who, with lewd or lascivious intent, engages in a pattern of inappropriate communication or conduct directed toward a child for the purpose of enticing such child to engage in any unlawful sexual behavior with that person or the exploitation of such child for human trafficking as provided in s. 787.06, commits lewd or lascivious grooming, a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
