27 Section 1. Section 320.08053, Florida Statutes, is amended 28 to read:

29 320.08053 <u>Establishment of</u> Requirements for requests to 30 establish specialty license plates.-

(1) If a specialty license plate requested by an organization is approved by law, the organization must submit the proposed art design for the specialty license plate to the department, in a medium prescribed by the department, as soon as practicable, but no later than 60 days after the act approving the specialty license plate becomes a law.

(2) (a) Within 120 days after following the specialty 37 license plate becomes becoming law, the department shall 38 39 establish a method to issue a specialty license plate voucher to allow for the presale of the specialty license plate. 163	(3) COLLEGIATE LICENSE PLATES
164	(a) The department shall develop a collegiate license
165	plate as provided in this section for state and independent
166	universities domiciled in this state. However, any collegiate

168	comply with the requirements of s. 320.08053 and be specifically
169	authorized by an act of the Legislature. Collegiate license
170	plates must bear the colors and design approved by the

The word "Florida" 217 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Donate 218 Organs-Pass It On" must appear at the bottom of the plate. 219 The annual use fees shall be distributed to Transplant (b) 220 Foundation, Inc., and shall use up to 10 percent of the proceeds 221 from the annual use fee for marketing and administrative costs 222 that are directly associated with the management and 223 distribution of the proceeds. The remaining proceeds shall be 224 used to provide statewide grants for patient services, including 225 preoperative, rehabilitative, and housing assistance; organ

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226 donor education and awareness programs; and statewide medical 227 research. 228 (69) ST. JOHNS RIVER LICENSE PLATES.-229 The department shall develop a St. Johns River (a) license plate as provided in this section. The St. Johns River license 230 231 plates must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the 232 plate, and the words "St. Johns River" must appear at the bottom 233 234 of the plate. 235 (b) The requirements of s. 320.08053 must be met prior 236 the issuance of the plate. Thereafter, the license plate annual 237 use fees shall be distributed to the St. Johns River Alliance, 238 Inc., a s. 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, which shall 239 administer the fees as follows: 240 1. The St. Johns River Alliance, Inc., shall retain the 241 first \$60,000 of the annual use fees as direct reimbursement for 242 administrative costs, startup costs, and costs incurred in the 243 development and approval process. 268	appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Hispanic
269	Achievers" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
270	(b) The proceeds from the license plate annual use fee
271	shall be distributed to National Hispanic Corporate Achievers,
272	Inc., a nonprofit corporation under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal
273	Revenue Code, to fund grants to nonprofit organizations to
274	operate programs and provide scholarships and for marketing the
275	Hispanic Achievers license plate. National Hispanic Corporate
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276	Achievers, Inc., shall establish a Hispanic Achievers Grant
277	Council that shall provide recommendations for statewide grants
278	from available Hispanic Achievers license plate proceeds to
279	nonprofit organizations for programs and scholarships for
280	Hispanic and minority Floridians. National Hispanic Corporate
281	Achievers, Inc., shall also establish a Hispanic Achievers

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475 Within 120 days after receiving an organization's (2) (a) 476 audit or attestation, the department shall determine which 477 recipients of revenues from specialty license plate annual use 478 fees have not complied with subsection (1). In determining 479 compliance, the department may commission an independent 480 actuarial consultant, or an independent certified public 481 accountant, who has expertise in nonprofit and charitable 482 organizations.

(b) The department must discontinue the distribution of revenues to any organization failing to submit the required documentation as required in subsection (1), but may resume distribution of the revenues upon receipt of the required information.

488 (C) If the department or its designee determines that an 489 organization has not complied or has failed to use the revenues 490 in accordance with ss. 320.08056 and 320.08058, the department 491 must discontinue the distribution of the revenues to the 492 organization. The department shall notify the organization of 493 its findings and direct the organization to make the changes 494 necessary in order to comply with this chapter. If the officers 495 of the organization sign an affidavit under penalties of perjury 496 stating that they acknowledge the findings of the department and attest that they have taken corrective action and that the 497 organization will submit to a followup review by the department, 498 499 the department may resume the distribution of revenues.

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500 (d) If an organization fails to comply with the 501 department's recommendations and corrective actions as outlined 502 in paragraph (c), the revenue distributions shall be 503 discontinued until completion of the next regular session of the 504 Legislature. The department shall notify the President of the 505 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by the 506 first day of the next regular session of any organization whose 507 revenues have been withheld as a result of this paragraph. If the Legislature does not provide direction to the organization 508 509 and the department regarding the status of the undistributed 510 revenues, the department shall deauthorize the plate and the 511 undistributed revenues shall be immediately deposited into the 512 Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund.

(3) The department or its designee has the authority to
examine all records pertaining to the use of funds from the sale
of specialty license plates.

530 (1) (a) Each owner or lessee of an automobile or truck for 531 private use or recreational vehicle as specified in s. 532 320.08(9)(c) or (d), which is not used for hire or commercial 533 use, who is a resident of the state and a veteran of the United 534 States Armed Forces, a Woman Veteran, a World War II Veteran, a 535 Navy Submariner, an active or retired member of the Florida 536 National Guard, a survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor, a 537 recipient of the Purple Heart medal, a recipient of the Bronze 538 Star, an active or retired member of any branch of the United 539 States Armed Forces Reserve, or a recipient of the Combat 540 Infantry Badge, Combat Medical Badge, Combat Action Badge, 541 Combat Action Ribbon, Air Force Combat Action Medal, or 542 Distinguished Flying Cross, upon application to the department, 543 accompanied by proof of release or discharge from any branch of 544 the United States Armed Forces, proof of active membership or 545 retired status in the Florida National Guard, proof of membership in the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association or proof of 546 active military duty in Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, proof 547 of being a Purple Heart medal recipient, proof of being a Bronze 548 549 Star recipient, proof of active or retired membership in any

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550 branch of the United States Armed Forces Reserve, or proof of 551 membership in the Combat Infantrymen's Association, Inc., proof 552 of being a recipient of the Combat Infantry Badge, Combat 553 Medical Badge, Combat Action Badge, Combat Action Ribbon, Air 554 Force Combat Action Medal, or Distinguished Flying Cross, and 555 upon payment of the license tax for the vehicle as provided in 556 s. 320.08, shall be issued a license plate as provided by s. 557 320.06 which, in lieu of the serial numbers prescribed by s. 320.06, is stamped with the words "Veteran," "Woman Veteran," 558 559 "WWII Veteran," "Navy Submariner," "National Guard," "Pearl 560 Harbor Survivor," "Combat-wounded veteran," "Bronze Star," "U.S. Reserve," "Combat Infantry Badge," "Combat Medical Badge," 561 "Combat Action Badge," "Combat Action Ribbon," "Air Force Combat 562 563 Action Medal," or "Distinguished Flying Cross," as appropriate, 564 and a likeness of the related campaign medal or badge, followed 565 by the serial number of the license plate. Additionally, the 566 Purple Heart plate may have the words "Purple Heart" stamped on 567 the plate and the likeness of the Purple Heart medal appearing 568 on the plate.
